### Electronic Scoring

You must have a transponder to be scored. Transponders will be available at sign-in for \$20 (purchase) or return after the entire race for a \$15 refund. **Special thanks to DENCO Racing and Mike Medwin for scoring and for the use of the software for this event.**

### Special Rules & Information

- \* **New Sportsman Class for advanced riders only wishing to complete 2 Laps (open class).**
- \* Pro class riders will compete for money only. Trophies will be awarded in all other classes.
- \* Spark arrestors are **MANDATORY !!** Screens will not be accepted.
- \* BLM requests all vehicles have their undercarriages washed off prior to entering the pit area to prevent the spread of noxious weeds.
- \* Fire extinguishers are required in all pits next to gas cans.

### About the Race

The Tarantula 100 course is approximately 100 miles through the desert near Alamogordo, NM. The course will consist of sand-washes, 2 track dirt roads, and jeep trails. The elevation is about 4300 ft. The number of loops will be as follows:

Pro / Experts	4 loops
Pro-Am / Amateurs	3 loops
Sportsman / Novice	2 loops
Ironman	1 loop

Loops will be approximately 27 miles.

**Pre-entry deadline is February 13th. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

**Late Entry Fee is an additional \$20.00**
